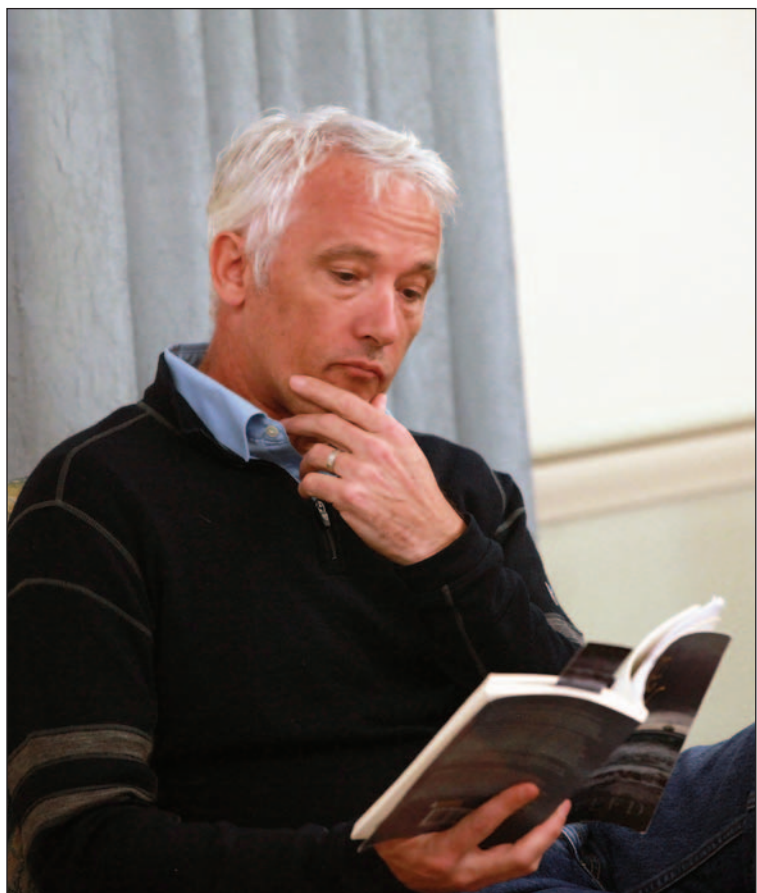


# Tim Weed at the Duxbury Free Library

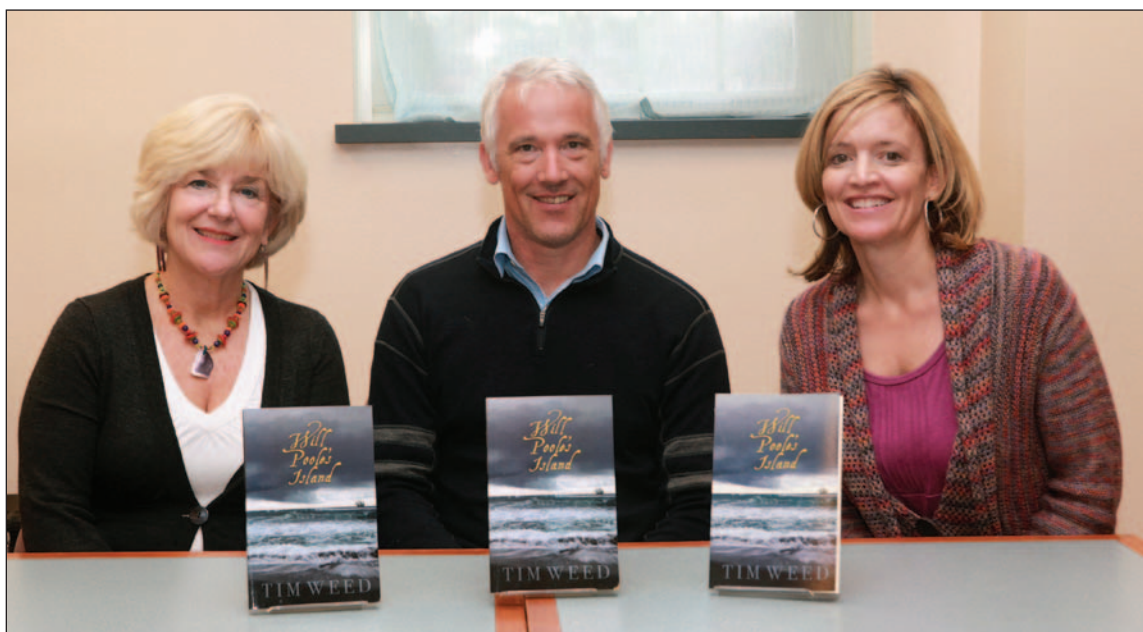


Weed read excerpts from his book after a discussion of his family history and the history of the colonies in the 1600 and 1700's.



All residences and businesses within the 10-mile emergency planning zone for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station will receive—through the mail—a 2015 Emergency Public Information calendar containing information on emergency procedures.

Share it and discuss it with your family and co-workers. It will help you to plan and respond to an emergency in the community by being informed and prepared.

This calendar is an important part of your community's emergency planning efforts to ensure the safety of Pilgrim's neighbors. Keep it in a central location for easy reference and be sure to fill out the tear-out Personal Planning Guide included in this year's calendar.

If you live in Carver (east of Route 58), Duxbury, Kingston, Marshfield (south of Route 139/Careswell Street-Dyke Road), or Plymouth, and do not receive your calendar by December 31, 2014, please contact your town's Emergency Management Agency.
